## STORM DEBRIS PICKUP HAS BEGUN!

270 tons of debris was removed off of the streets of Youngsville! Collection will resume Saturday morning at 7am and will continue in Highland Ridge subdivision and Beacon / Lahasky Streets. Debris pickup may also begin in other areas on Saturday afternoon. Note: On Sunday, traffic may be restricted on Hill Ridge Drive while debris is collected on this street. As a reminder, if debris needs to be picked up, please do not put in trailers or next to mailboxes, cable or electric boxes. Also remember debris cannot be picked up if vehicles are blocking the property. Thank you for your assistance as we continue to clean up and restore our city!

Reminder: If you have debris on private property outside of the city right away, a hold harmless agreement must be signed. It can be done online [here](#) or in person at City Hall before debris can be removed.
