MARDI GRAS TIME

January 4, 2019

We have already started plans for the March 2, 2019, Youngsville Mardi Gras Parade. One of our objectives is to eliminate the float lineup congestion. We are also very concerned about public safety and keeping the Youngsville Mardi Gras Parade a wholesome/family oriented event for all to enjoy.

THE PARADE ROUTE IS THE SAME AS LAST YEAR, 4 MILES LONG, STARTING AND ENDING ON CHEMIN METAIRIE AT THE YOUNGVILLE SPORTS COMPLEX (PLEASE SEE MAP OF ROUTE)! The parade will lineup at the intersection of Savoy Road and Chemin Metairie at the Youngsville Sports Complex. All parade participants will be lined up along Chemin Metairie going toward Hwy. 92. The parade will follow Chemin Metairie to Hwy. 92 and proceed right to Hwy. 89, then turning right on Church Street before ending at the Youngsville Sports Complex on Detente'. Please take note that the route is 4 miles long this year! All bands and dance schools will meet at the Sports Complex Recreation Center parking lot on Savoy road and will be entered into the parade from there. School buses will be allowed to park at the Recreation Center parking lot where their participants will line up. No other vehicles will be allowed to park in this designated area. All traffic along the parade route will be restricted beginning at 8:00A.M. and the parade will begin promptly at 11:00A.M.

Prior to the parade, float Permits can be purchased at City Hall Monday thru Friday between the hours of 7:30A.M. and 4:00P.M. or online at Youngsville.us. Parade permits for Floats are \$175.00 and single vehicles are \$100.00. Trailers must be less than 40' in length and the sides must be at least 4' in height. Double decker floats can be no higher than 13'

All floats will be inspected prior to being allowed in the lineup. Only floats that have riders and beads on board will be lined up in the parade, please do not try and drop off float participants or decorate floats, on site. If a float or vehicle is not parade ready they will be moved to a holding area until the time the float or vehicle is parade ready. Please have your permit displayed on the passenger side of the float or vehicle for check in and it must remain for the duration of the parade.

The rules of conduct which include, PROFANITY & VULGAR MUSIC in any form shall be grounds for instant removal. Also, tossing of BEVERAGES & ANIMALS in any form shall be grounds for instant removal from the parade. NO REFUNDS IF A FLOAT OR VEHICLE IS REMOVED FROM THE PARADE.

Additional information will be provided with the float/vehicle parade permit. Please keep in mind that our ultimate goal is to have a safe/family oriented parade.
