DISASTER RECOVERY SERVICES
REMIEDIATION OF IMMEDIATE THREATS

It may be necessary to provide massive disaster recovery services to preserve and protect the health and safety of the citizens of the City of YOUNGSVILLE in the immediate aftermath of a Hurricane (or other disaster).

The CONTRACTOR will agree to remove all hazards to life and property as quickly as possible resulting from an event. Cleanup and removal will be limited to (1) that which is determined by the City to eliminate immediate threats of significant damage to life, public health and safety; (2) that which has been determined to eliminate immediate threats of significant damage to improved public or private property; and (3) that which is considered essential to ensure economic recovery of the effected community to the benefit of the community-at-large.

The CONTRACTOR shall provide and pay for all labor, tools, equipment, transportation, fuel, supervision, and all other services and facilities of any nature whatsoever necessary to execute, complete and deliver the services within the time specified as agreed upon by both parties (THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE AND THE CONTRACTOR).

The CONTRACTOR shall name the City of YOUNGSVILLE as additional insured on the CONTRACTOR'S insurance policies. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain the following insurance limits:

Workers Compensation – Statutory Limits of the State of Louisiana
General Liability – One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) any single occurrence
Additional Liability Umbrella – Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00)

The CONTRACTOR shall provide the City of YOUNGSVILLE a certificate of insurance evidencing such coverage. Required insurance shall be documented in certificates of insurance, which provide that the City of YOUNGSVILLE shall be notified at least 30 days in advance of cancellation, non-renewal, or adverse changes. New certificates of insurance are to be provided to the City of YOUNGSVILLE at least 15 days prior to coverage renewals. Receipt of certificates or other documentation of insurance or policies or copies of policies by the City of YOUNGSVILLE or by any of its representatives, which indicate less coverage than is required, does not constitute a waiver of CONTRACTOR'S obligation to fulfill the insurance herein.

Contract award will be based on an evaluation by a selection committee utilizing the following point system:

Company qualifications and experience – shows experience with FEMA and GOHSEP, familiarity with the City of Youngsville	0-30 points
Shows similar project experience, experience with FEMA (higher points will be given for projects completed in the Youngsville)	0-30 points
Accessibility and Availability of Resources: location for minimal travel time to respond quickly, availability to mobilize immediately upon Notice to Proceed.	0-30 points
Ability to discard debris without staging, (landfill site location close to Youngsville will receive higher points)	0-30 points
Pricing	0-30 points

The term of the contract will be for 1 year with an option to renew for up to 3 additional years.

CONTRACTOR shall provide a contract price (\$_____Per cubic yard) for collection and transportation of disaster-generated wood waste and construction debris only to a landfill, burn site approved by DEQ or other sites designated by the City of YOUNGSVILLE.

Disposal fee for wood waste and construction debris is \$_____Per cubic yard.

Unacceptable waste, such as furniture, mattresses, appliances, household waste, etc. will be transported and disposed of at proper landfills for \$_____/ton.
