- Wastewater Plant – working on permitting.
- Pump Station 4 - working on an estimate to apply for another water sector grant.
- Downtown Streetscape - force main installed and tested. Drainage is 90% complete. Projected completion for November.
- Water Plant - working on cost estimate.
- Water Well 9 - drilling may begin in November. Subcontractor to mobilize next week to run water lines.
- Elevated Water Storage Tank – Geotechnical report in progress. Project must be submitted by October 1st.
- Bonin Rd – drainage work to facilitate road widening has begun.
- Foster Park Road on track to be complete before school starts.
- Savoy/CMP Roundabout - contractor hopes to be complete when school starts.
- Hwy. 89 & Fortune Rd. Projects under design. RFQ to go out in few weeks.
- 2022 Road Improvement Project – Bid advertisement to go out soon.
- Regional Detention Lakes – Railroad St. has reopened. Installing outfall pipes that will accept water from Bayou Parc Perdue.
- E. Milton Rd. improvements - projecting design completion for February/March.
- Police Department - phone app went live today.
- Sports Complex - Girls All-Star World Series is complete. Bronco Boys won their regionals & are going to Deer Park, TX to play in the next tournament. Shetland Pinto World Series - July 20 at Sports Complex. Pony Boys World Series on July 27. Sugar Beach Volleyball Glow tournaments - around 30 teams. Sugar Beach league - 112 teams. Friday night LVL Junior League - 45 teams. FNA football Spring League is complete and beginning registration for the Fall League. Adult softball league and indoor volleyball

registration has begun. Basketball camps - 6 camps capped at 80 kids per camp. Several new sponsors purchased courts/fields as well as some sponsors have renewed their naming rights.

- Sports Complex Special Events: FASA softball world series - 42 teams. USSSA Adult Softball World Series - 47 teams. Shetland Pinto World Series - opening ceremonies will be held at Russo Park on July 20th at 9 am., tournament starting at 2pm with 40 teams. Mustang World Series Breakfast Banquet - July 29 at 9am, opening ceremonies will begin at 4:30pm. Leadership Youngsville will throw the first pitches. Mardi Gras Mambo Tournament - Flow Sports wants to live stream for the next 5 years.
- Foster Park is about 95% complete.
- Golf carts – commended the staff for increased awareness and organizing the registration process.
- Municipal Complex – progress is moving along in the interior and exterior of the building & is still on schedule for completion.
- Congratulated Mr. & Mrs. Clint Simoneaux on the birth of their daughter, Mary.
- Lafayette Councilman Carlson updated the City on various projects in conjunction with LCG and the City.
