- Water & Sewer Projects: Water Treatment Plant - amending design to decrease costs, also pending approval of a bid extension from Water Sector Committee. Pump Station 4 – amending plans to reduce costs. Sugar Mill Pond upgrade – working on location of new parallel force main.
- Road Projects: 2022 Roadway - working on milling and overlay on Devon Way & Fieldcrest. Hwy 89/Fortune Rd - moving dirt to location of road, GMP received for both projects, pending concurrence from FPC. Southern East West Connector - working with property owners followed by appraisals for future purchases. Prescott/Hwy 92 Roundabout - moving forward with preliminary plans.
